Shoot Coordinator's Report Extreme Rimfire March 15 Shoot

Wind, rain, hail, fog, tornado warnings barometer changes up and down. These were just a few of the problems that the 15 brave shooters had to contend with Saturday at our March 15 ER shoot. The first part of the morning proved to be the best shooting time as evidenced by Breezy's score of 39 in the benchrest division. Now I'm not saying that he is not capable of shooting a 39, what I am saying is he got lucky.

Robby Lawrence and Ron York were right on his heels with 38's and Thaxton Stafford with a 37. Breezy that was excellent shooting under any conditions.

Breezy was the first one to arrive and set up targets by himself in the fog. When I arrived I could hardly see him down on the ram line. The fog cleared up enough a little after nine so we started shooting. Some where around 12 o'clock it started raining and around 2 o'clock we started getting phone calls about a possible tornado sighting. other entries will be 5.00. Juniors will not pay any fees.
