

RULES & REQUIREMENTS

Thanks for the opportunity to help. Here are the requirements for CGC youth shooting program which we feel you'll find more than reasonable.....

CGC CLUB RULES

ÉCGC insurance requires that everyone on the ranges be at least 8 years old. Those 7 and younger must stay in the Clubhouse or upper parking lot.

ÉEveryone on the ranges must wear eye and ear protection at all times. CGC provides free ear plugs.

ÉAll guns must remain unloaded at all times, unless the Range Officer tells you otherwise.

ÉAll shooters must know the 4 rules of safe shooting before shooting starts.

YOUTH SHOOTING RULES

ÉEach shooter needs to be accompanied by an adult. That person could be a parent or an adult leader.

ÉIf the parent or custodial guardian is not present, then the shooter must bring a signed copy of the CGC Medical Release, available on this web page.

ÉAll shooters must bring a signed copy of the CGC Legal Waiver, available on this web page.

ÉShooters and adults have to provide their own safety glasses, drinking cup and lunch. CGC provides hearing protection, water, electricity, restrooms, reserved shooting lanes and fun!

ÉWe assume that all shooters will bring their own guns and ammunition unless discussed in advance.

We are always happy to advise on ammunition choices if you need help.

ÉWe assume that groups will bring their own councilors. That is, Boy Scouts will bring their own merit badge councilors.

ÉShooters pay a low all-day shooting fee, plus the price of any clay targets. See the cost sheet.

ÉWhen making payment, bring exact change or a check book. We do not have an ATM or a cashier.

ÉTo qualify for Shotgun merit badge, BSA requires the Rifle Shooting merit badge as a prerequisite.

However, at CGC any youth who can handle a gun responsibly is more than welcome to try shotgun.

ÉThe maximum number of active shooters is 5. If your group is large, then we can break this into shifts or devise other plans as needed. Group size is important for your safety. Please consult with us first.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

ÉNo smoking on the firing line

ÉMaximum speed of 10 MPH within CGC property limits

ÉAll rifle shooting will be conducted from a shooting bench

ÉAll shooting will be fired single shot with one round loaded at a time
